CDSA received several applications for this coveted positon. Mr. Daniels is very involved in the Deaf sports community for over 35 years as an athlete, member of Board of Directors, commissioner, events organizer. He also held several roles on the Canadian Mission Team for various sport events.

"I am honoured to be selected as Chef de mission for the Canadian Team at the 2019 Winter Deaflympics. I am looking forward to work with the athletes, staff

and team. I am eager to start preparations," said Mr. Daniels.
