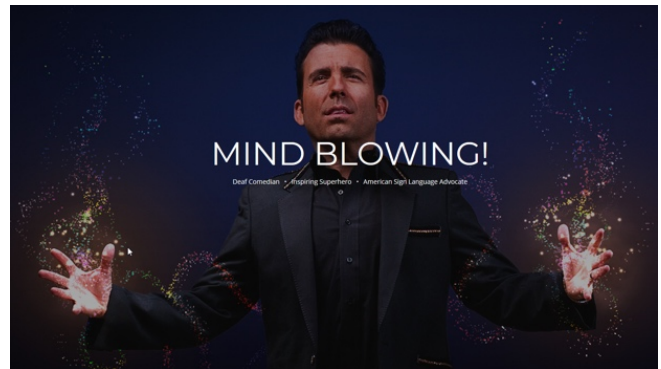




The John Maucere show a big hit for the Canada Deaf Games 2020 Host Committee
