### FENLANDS BANFF RECREATION CENTRE

A striking facility for community gatherings and elite competitions.

Originally constructed in the early 60s, the Fenlands Recreation Centre required an ambitious redevelopment to provide contemporary athletic facilities in a building that highlights the Banff National Park surroundings. Working with the community and town, GEC completed a feasibility study and needs assessment which developed a program and concept for a new multi-use facility. The result is a new facility featuring a refurbished 500-seat arena and new ice surface, a new second ice rink, new curling rink, dryland training space, and community and professional sized change rooms.

The new recreation centre supports community use with meeting rooms, auxiliary change rooms and training spaces, and an upgraded concourse area designed for large public events. The site was completely redeveloped to create public pedestrian spaces that showcase the natural environment and historic memorabilia is displayed throughout the facility.

Sustainable initiatives include ecosystem restoration and reclamation involving the removal of invasive plant species and the re-introduction of native grasses, shrubs and trees. Creek banks that were subject to human traffic-induced erosion were also stabilized and replanted with native species. Other sustainable features include the use of recycled glulam beams from the demolished curling rink, the use of natural materials such as local rundlestone and limestone in the landscape, and protection of riparian habitats by siting the building as far away as possible from existing creeks and careful control of stormwater runoff, including bioswales.





The Caribou Lodge & Spa is the official lodgings: it provides free transportation from the resort to the sports venue and back.

The Banff Caribou Lodge & Spa is located in Banff National Park and provides mountain lodge-style hotel accommodations, a great steakhouse restaurant, and a full-service spa all in one outstanding setting. This ideal vacation spot is surrounded by mountains and can be found on Banff Avenue, the main street in the Town of Banff. Conveniently, it is located only a short walk from the town centre.

The superior rooms include two queen size signature mountain luxury beds with plush down duvets, a desk/table sitting area, mini-fridges, coffee/tea makers, hair dryer, iron/board, and cable television. Also provided are complimentary wireless internet access, a ROAM (Banff Transit) pass, and a Best of Banff coupon booklet offering discounts at many local shops and pubs.

The Banff Caribou Lodge & Spa has a 35-person jet hot pool & steam room & climate-controlled exercise room. A breakfast buffet is included as a part of the accommodations.

## EMERGENCY PROCEDURES



Please familiarize yourself with the site plan, including the Emergency Evacuation Meeting Place.

### FIRE ALARM

If the fire alarm is activated, you will see strobe or flashing lights. STOP YOUR ACTIVITIES and vacate the facility immediately. Close the doors as you leave but do not lock. Proceed to the **Emergency Evacuation Meeting Place** located at the east end of the main parking lot by the large red sign, and wait for further directions. You will be asked to account for everyone in your group.

### **AMMONIA LEAK**

If there is an ammonia leak the staff will activate the fire alarm. When it is activated, you will see strobe or flashing lights. STOP YOUR ACTIVITIES and vacate the facility immediately. Close the doors as you leave but do not lock. Proceed to the **Emergency Evacuation Meeting Place** located at the east end of the main parking lot by the large red sign, and wait for further directions. You will be asked to account for everyone in your group.

### **POWER OUTAGE**

The facility has enough capacity to provide lighting for twenty minutes. If the power goes out, Fenlands Staff will contact local power provider to determine how long power may be off for. If power cannot be restored within ½ hour the facility will be evacuated and all doors will be locked. No one will be allowed access to the facility without proper permission from the Facilities Supervisor or designate.

### INJURIES

All injuries must be reported immediately to the staff at the facility. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to go to the front desk.
