



Pan American Deaf Basketball Qualification (1) October 28 to November 5, 2022 in Buenos Aires, Argentina

1) Competition and costs

- a. Goal of the tournament: Qualifying tournament for the 2025 Summer Deaflympics.
- b. Cost of the trip (plane, accommodation and meals): Estimated at \$2,500
- c. Funding:
 - CDSA pays 50% = \$1,250
 - Player pays (50%) = \$1,250

2) Team Canada - Selection of players by CDSA

- a. The CDSA Basketball Committee (Jean-Marc Major and Mike Cyr) as well as Coach Antonin Jadoul will make a summary evaluation of the players during the Canada Deaf Games competition which will take place in Laval (Qc) from July 5 to 8, 2022
- b. For players who cannot show up in July 2022 in Laval (Qc), there will be an Evaluation Camp in Toronto on Saturday August 6 from noon to 4:00 p.m. at Ryerson University. Coach Antonin Jadoul will be on site.
- c. Around August 10, an invitation letter will be sent to players to be part of Team Canada for the trip to Argentina.

3) Interest and registration

- a. The player who is able to plan to pay his share of \$ 1,250 for Argentina can show his interest and register no later than June 30, 2022 at alain.turpin@assc-cdsa.com
- b. If the player is attending the Canada Deaf Games in July 2022 in Laval, QC, the player will not need to attend the Evaluation Camp on August 6 in Toronto
- c. If the player has not registered for the Canada Deaf Games in Laval in July 2022, it is mandatory to participate in the Evaluation Camp in Toronto on August 6.
