Role of the CDSA and Team Manager (Sport)

CDSA is responsible to send its National Team to the World Championships, to the PanAm Games & to the Summer Deaflympics and to form a Mission Team. The Women Volleyball Team Manager is a vital part of the Mission Team as well as for athletes and coaches. The Team Manager reports directly to the CDSA Executive Director.

Responsibilities and Competencies

The Team Manager in conjunction with the Head Coach, assumes responsibility of all areas related to the sport's operations both within and outside the competition area. CDSA and the Mission Team put an important emphasis on athlete services during the Worlds, PanAm Games & Deaflympics Games. The Team Manager must at all times focus on the athletes and their needs.

The Team Manager should have the appropriate level of coaching knowledge, skills and experience to support athletes in their preparation before and during the Worlds & Deaflympics. These duties will be performed in addition to related administrative and management duties. The Team Manager required competencies are described in Annex A.

ANNEX A TEAM MANAGER COMPETENCIES

Sport Management and Technical Knowledge

- Understanding management principles and their application to managing a sport national team;
- Understanding differences in demands made by Team Managers and those of the National Team;
- Demonstrates technical knowledge in their sport; and
- Demonstrates knowledge of specific rules and procedures from the International Federation (of the sport) to help understand administrative procedures and specific technical requirements for athletes and other officials.

Organization Skills

- Demonstrates a clear understanding of issues related to managing a national team and implications of being involved in the Canadian Team; and
- Capacity to plan and implement activities, coordinate human resources, and maintain appropriate monitoring and control.

Human Resources Management, Decision Making and Communication

- Interpersonal and management skills to successfully motivate and direct team members;
- Works effectively with people by showing respect and care to their needs;
- Provide all necessary information regarding the sport to athletes before, during and after the games;
- Support and provide, if relevant, fundraising ideas to athletes;
- Demonstrates a logical and rational approach in weighing up issues and making a decision; and
- Excellent communication skills. If necessary, fluent in ASL and/or LSQ.

Commitment

- Shows enthusiasm and prepared to put athletes' performance before personal considerations; and
- Available to travel with the national team to all pre-event competitions and preparations as well as attend all team meetings and gatherings.
