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ABOUT BARSEBÄCK RESORT



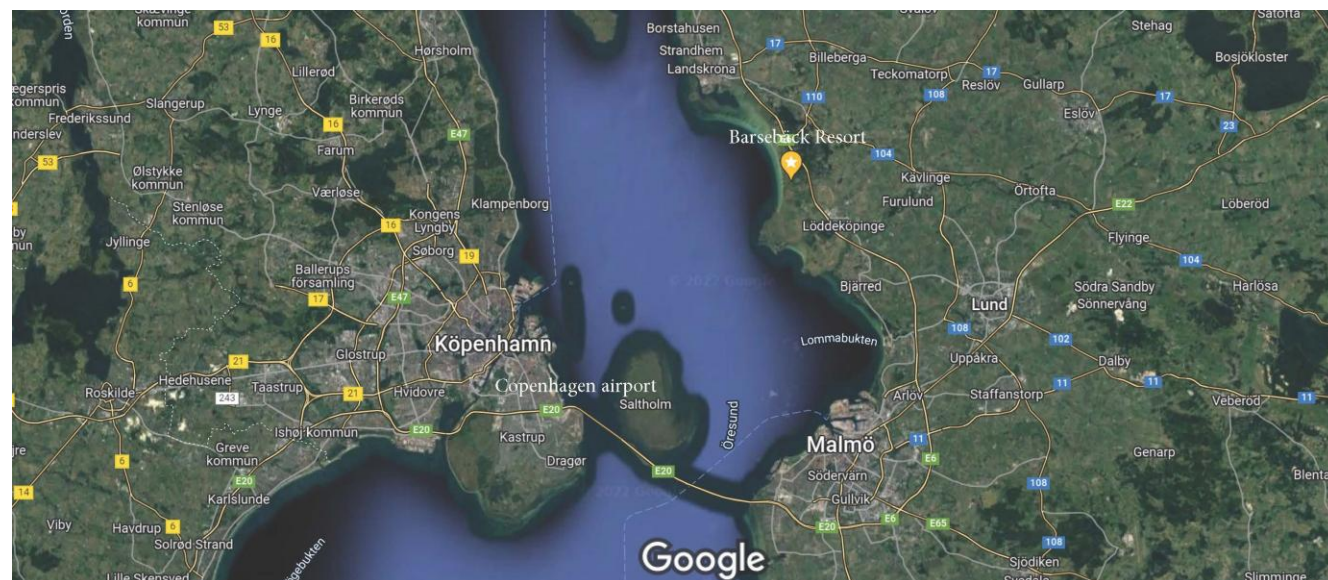
THE RESORT

Barsebäck was originally built in 1969 and has hosted 12 DP World Tour events with winners including Nick Faldo, Lee Westwood, Colin Montgomery and Jesper Parnevik. In 2003, the Solheim Cup was held at Barsebäck where Europe won over USA. One of Barsebäck's most famous members is Henrik Stenson, who has the family summer house nearby.

BARSEBÄCK LOCATION

Barsebäck lies along the Öresund, which is the water that forms the border between Sweden and Denmark. Among other things, the TV series The Bridge is recorded on both sides of the Öresund Bridge.

The nearest international airport is Copenhagen Airport, which is approximately 65 kilometers away.

OCEAN COURSE

To play the Ocean Course is to take a journey. You will wander among copper colored pine trunks, beautiful park holes and struggle not to be distracted by the view from the seaside holes. We have thinned out the trees so that you can always feel the presence of the sea. The course has hosted 12 DP World Tour events and the Solheim Cup 2003.

PINE COURSE

The Pine Course offers beautiful scenery and an exciting golf experience among wind-swept pines in beautiful Scanian nature. Here you are challenged by water hazards, tree trunks and terrain that make this a fantastic golfing experience. We recently made major improvements to give you an experience you'll want to come back to.

6.000 yards and 5.500 yards
